### Collective Worship this Year

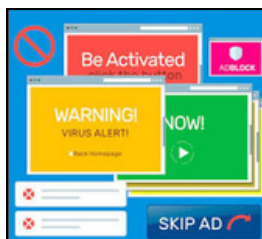
