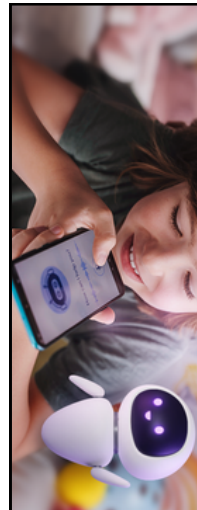


Collective Worship

Online Safety AI Friends? Do You Know the Danger?

Is your child using AI without knowing it? You Tube and other commonly used content provider apps have frequent invitations to AI "buddies", "friends", and "pets", etc. which your child may not have the critical skills to spot, or may think are without risk. These tools are not considered good for young children's mental and emotional development and can have sexual aspects and be used in the abuse of children. Keep checking your child's usage, having conversations, and keep dialogue open. The internet's like a busy road: designed for adults, very useful and hazardous if not used carefully. If we don't keep them safe, they are in danger.,. It's sadly as simple as that.

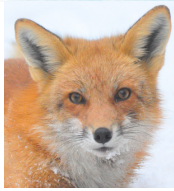
