






Over the Hills!


Our focus stories for this term will include 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl, the Mr Gumpy books by John Burningham and texts by Eric Carle. We will be learning all about Malvern and the Malvern Hills. We will be exploring Malvern as a town, what makes it the town that it is and how and why it developed over time. We will be considering how people travel in and around Malvern. We will also be exploring the wildlife of our school grounds and the hills paying particular attention to the small creatures and invertebrates that live there. Our journey end will see us invite our parents to a Garden Party to find out what we have learnt on the way.

<p>Outdoor Games and Athletics We will be exploring outdoor games. We will practice our athletics skills. We will be having some expert cricket coaching and will be looking forward to our sports day event.</p> 
Art & Design
<p>Painting and Mixed media We are going to be focussing on landscape both urban and rural. We will be paying special attention to the horizon line and will be creating our own landscapes using a blend of paint and collage.</p>  <p>3D Modelling Watch this space for an invasion of giant invertebrates as we work collaboratively to produce some 'mega' minibeasts! We will also be working with clay and wire to create some slightly smaller creatures of our own.</p>

Geography
<p>Geographical Knowledge We will be looking at Malvern and considering what makes it a town. We will be looking at the roads and travel infrastructure of the area. We will be reading simple maps and finding out the meanings of the symbols we find on them.</p> <p>Geographical Skills and Fieldwork We will carry out a traffic survey at school and at our homes to help us to consider why some roads are busier than others. We will be learning about road safety and the best places for our parents and carers to park when bringing and collecting us from school and why. We will be exploring why people visit Malvern, how they travel there and how far they have travelled.</p>

<p>We will explore the STRIVE values that we have developed and adopted as a school. <p>We will learn about Edward Elgar and how the Malvern Hills inspired some of our most recognisable pieces of classical music and about the close links he had with our school.</p> <p>We will learn songs with a vehicle and minibeast theme. History
<p>We will learn about the History of Transport in Malvern and how the transport links developed, including the growth of roads, rail links, the Morgan factory and Great Malvern Railway.</p> <p>We will look at trains and cars and how they have changed beyond living memory and create chronological timelines.</p>   <p>We will look at the Wyche cutting, why it was created and what it was used for.</p>
